Footy Clinic

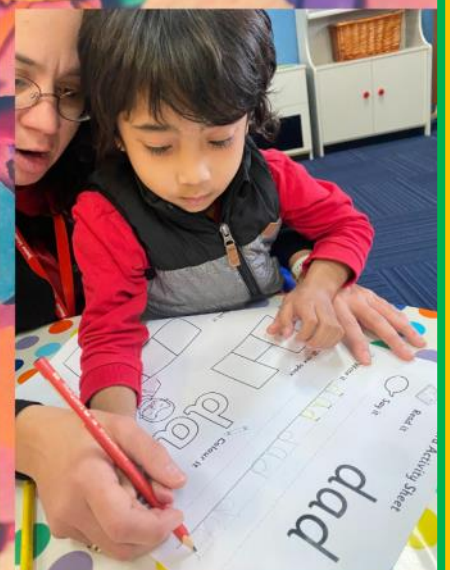

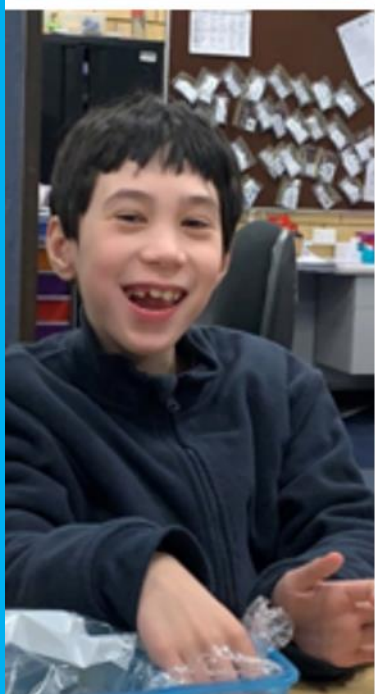

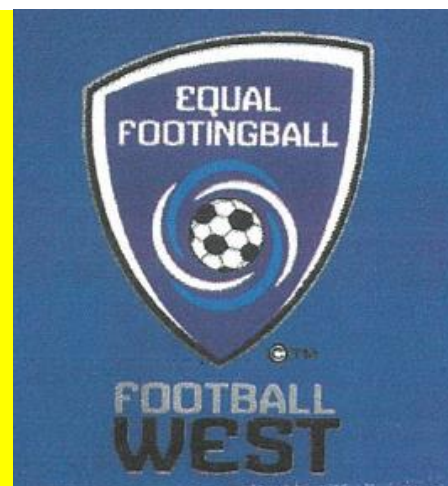
